ABM Janitorial Services likes to recount how the industry has changed in the many years it has been in existence. In the past, all one needed to start a janitorial service was cleaning supplies. Today, ABM says clients expect a cleaning service that helps employers, property owners and managers enhance the value of their investments, attract new tenants and retain present ones by providing a clean workplace.

ABM Janitorial Services is a subsidiary of ABM Industries. The company's Arizona operations are part of its south-central region. ABM was founded almost 100 years ago in San Francisco and began its operations in Arizona more than 50 years ago.

Over the past 20 years, ABM Janitorial Services in Arizona has gone from 80 workers cleaning some 1 million square feet, to 1,700 employees servicing more than 750 locations and cleaning 35 million square feet today. The Arizona operations now boast offices in Phoenix and Tucson.

ABM's economic impact to the state is both direct and indirect. Along with payroll, sales and other local and state taxes, ABM's multi-million-dollar contributions to the state's economy include the leasing of its office space, the purchase of communications equipment, vehicles, fuel, maintenance, uniforms, cleaning equipment and supply purchases.

The company also has a strong presence in the community. It is a member of the Building Owners and Managers Association of Greater Phoenix (BOMA). In its 21 years as a BOMA member, ABM Janitorial Services has participated in the organization's local and national events, and representatives have served on major committees. ABM has received the Outstanding Committee Member and Outstanding Associate Member of the Year from BOMA.

The company is also a member of the Valley Hotel and Resort Association's board of directors, the International Facility Management Association and Scottsdale Healthcare's board of directors. In addition, ABM employees donate time and money to the Boys and Girls Club, the Salvation Army and the Red Cross.
